### REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

Minimum of 120 hours credit. Minimum of 60 hours credit from 4-year school. Minimum of 36 hours credit in 300/400 level courses. Minimum of 30 hours credit at JSU. Minimum of 12 hours credit in 300/400 level courses in major at JSU. Minimum of 6 hours credit in 300/400 level courses in minor at JSU. Grade of 'C' or better in all major and minor courses and in English 101 and 102. **Math (MS) 204 is required as the second MS class for Track I & MS 113 or higher is required for Track II.** Must have minimum of 2.5 GPA in major, minor and overall. Must complete all courses required for major and minor. Must successfully complete the English Competency Exam. Must take EPP exam. STU 101 must be taken by students with less than 24 earned hours. Must take the FI Major Field Test during Senior Capstone Course semester.
