**Teacher Education
Transition Point Requirements**

1. Requirements prior to eligibility to Teacher Education

- a. Minimum 60 semester hours
- b. Successfully complete the Teacher Education Program Orientation Course ED 300.
- c. Successfully complete the Secondary Education Introduction to Educational Foundations course: ESE300
- d. Successfully complete all three components of the Alabama Educator Certification Testing Program (AECTP)
- e. Overall 2.75 GPA or higher.
- f. Complete an application for the TEP.
- g. Complete "Letter of Understanding."
- h. Fingerprinting via Cogent (provide proof of background clearance from ALSDE).
- i. Candidate interview by program committee.
- j. Three Letters of Recommendation.

2. Eligibility to Preservice Teaching (Internship)

- a. Minimum 2.75 GPA overall, JSU courses only, on all Professional Studies and all Teaching Field courses.
- b. Minimum grade of C is required on all Professional Studies and Teaching Field courses.
- c. PRAXIS II and PLT—passing score required for each Praxis II exam required for each certification area. Refer to the College of Education & Professional Studies website for specific details on each Praxis II examination www.jsu.edu/edprof/ and consult with advisor for updated information on Praxis II requirements for selected teacher education program.* *Candidates are advised to check both the test code and the cut score prior to registering to take the exams because the state requirements will be enforced even if they change in the middle of a candidate's program.*

3. Minimum requirements for application for certification and graduation

- a. English Competency Exam (ECE)—passing score required.*
- b. EPP (ETS Proficiency Profile)* (Eligible at 90+ semester hours)*
- c. MFT (Major Field Test)** (eligible semester of graduation)
- d. Complete an undergraduate application for degree.
- e. Complete all certification requirements (application for certification, required fees, and transcript request forms).
- f. Minimum 2.75 GPA overall, JSU courses only, and on all Professional Studies and all Teaching Field courses.
- g. Minimum grade of C is required on all Professional Studies and Teaching Field courses.
- h. Minimum 128 Total Hours.
- i. 52 hours 300/400 level.
- j. 64 Semester hours credit at a 4-year institution.
- k. 32 Semester hours credit at JSU.
