PARENT FINANCIAL AID GUIDE



Make sure student completes FAFSA each year to see if they are eligible for grants, loans, and work study

- » Students will need to create a username (also known as an FSA ID) and password
- » Students can renew their FAFSA each year beginning on October 1st for the next aid year
- » Parent tax information requirement (Two years prior Example: 2021 School year= 2019 tax info)



Competitive Scholarships

Students can fill out the JAXAPP each year by February 1 for competitive scholarships

Communication from the Financial Aid Office is sent to your student's email







- » Parents must receive permission from the student for us to speak with you
- » Students can set-up their parent as a proxy to receive information regarding financial aid, student accounts, etc

Merit scholarship information

- » Awarded upon admission to JSU
- » Renewal requirements (2.0 GPA, full-time in fall and spring semester, earn 24 credit hours)
- » All out-of-state students receiving a merit scholarship automatically receive in-state tuition rates

Satisfactory Academic Progress

Must maintain 2.0 GPA and pass 66.67% of all classes to receive aid



Enroll in a Payment Plan or Making a Payment

- » Students can set up a payment plan for \$50 by visiting their MyJSU account and selecting "View Account/Make Payment"
- » Students can then select "Payment Plans" and then enroll in plan for the specific term
- » Students can also view their bill and pay their entire balance

Financial Programs

- » Subsidized vs. unsubsidized loans
 - -Subsidized= no interest accrues while enrolled
 - -Unsubsidized= interest accrues while enrolled
- » Pell Grant= funds that do not have to be repaid
- » PLUS Loans
 - -Parents can apply at studentaid.gov
- » Private student loans
