SPRING 2019 COMMENCEMENT

Instructions for Candidates

When and Where to Report: All candidates will report to Kennamer Hall one hour prior to the ceremony in complete regalia.

What to do Upon Arrival: Undergraduate candidates will check-in at their appropriate school's table. Graduate level candidates will check-in at the Graduate Studies' table. Name cards will be distributed at the check-in table, as well as, gold honor cords for spring undergraduate candidates who qualify for Latin honors after final Spring 2019 grades are posted. The name card will be scanned prior to the candidate crossing the stage. This will allow for the candidate's name and degree name to be displayed on the screen as they cross the stage. It is the candidate's responsibility to keep up with the name card, as well as, not to damage the card.

Processional: 30 minutes prior to the ceremony, Graduation Assistants will start assembling each school's candidates into separate lines. Approximately 25 minutes prior to the ceremony, School marshals will lead candidates by school from Kennamer Hall to their seats which will be located on Burgess Snow Field at JSU Stadium. All candidates will remain in single file lines until seated. It is important to make all last-minute preparations prior to the lineup. Crossing the Stage: School marshals will direct candidates to the stage at the appropriate time. All candidates should bring their name card to the stage with them. After crossing the stage, all candidates must return to their seats.

Photographs: Photographs will be taken by a professional, university approved photographer as candidates shake the hand of the President and after candidates exit the stage.

Recessional: Platform members will exit first in the recessional, followed by faculty, and then graduates. School marshals will release students by rows to exit the field. Prior to the ceremony, be sure to establish a location to meet with your family and guests following the ceremony.

Duration: The ceremony is expected to last approximately 2 hours. Out of respect for all degree candidates, once seated, all participants are expected to stay until the conclusion of the ceremony.

Apparel: It is recommended that candidates wear apparel appropriate for the occasion. Comfortable shoes are recommended due to the length of the procession and the soft terrain of the Burgess Snow Field.

Personal Belongings: Kennamer Hall is not a secure area to leave belongings. Please plan to leave personal belongings with family members or guests. The university is not responsible for any unattended personal items.
