Spotlight – Housing



The housing application for Fall 2025 opens today, October 10th! Freshmen are required to live on campus, but [exemptions](#) may apply for certain local students. The priority deadline to apply for housing is April 1st, and a non-refundable fee of

\$200 is required to submit your application.

Students living on campus will self-select their housing assignment and roommates. Housing selection will take place in April 2025 and is on a first-come, first-served basis based on the date and time of application submission (and parent verification completion). All applications are completed online, and roommate selection is available through RoomSync – an app that allows you to match with other students based on your living preferences. All students wishing to self-select housing must be registered for orientation by April 1st. Students interested in living in our newest freshman hall, North Village, should consider applying early for the best chance of securing a spot.
