Spotlight – Scholarships & Financial Aid



Merit-Based Scholarships: At Jax State, these scholarships are automatically awarded to accepted freshmen based on their highest cumulative high school GPA, with no additional application needed—just one of the ways we make the process easier for you. Students who have a composite ACT or SAT score on file may qualify for a higher-valued scholarship, and updated test scores can be submitted until May 1 for reconsideration.

Test scores will not have the ability to lower your scholarship amount, only improve it. If you have any questions about your merit-based scholarship offer, we're here to help!

Freshman Merit-Based Scholarship Structure »

Competitive Scholarships: The key to remembering these scholarships is that you need to "compete" for them by completing an application. There are several types of competitive scholarships:

- 1. **Leadership and Honors Scholarships:** These are exclusively for incoming freshmen, and each has its own set of criteria for students to apply.
- 2. **Performance Scholarships:** Available to both incoming and current Jax State students, these include scholarships in Theatre and Film, as well as Music & Band. Students interested in majoring in music at Jax State must audition for admission to the Dr. David L. Walters Department of Music. Your audition for a music scholarship (band, piano, vocal, or jazz) will also serve as your audition for the department.
- 3. **JAX App:** This is a simple, all-in-one application that allows both incoming and current students to apply for over 250 competitive scholarships. For example, an incoming freshman can apply for the Leadership Scholarship and also complete the JAX App to be considered for additional opportunities.

Each of these scholarships has its own application process, so be sure to review the requirements carefully below!

Competitive Foundation Scholarship Info »

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®): The 2025-2026 FAFSA, which all students starting in Fall 2025 need to complete, opens on December 1, 2024. Colleges and career schools use the FAFSA® to determine your eligibility for financial aid, including grants, need-based scholarships, work-study funds, and loans.

You must submit the FAFSA ® each year, but don't worry—with the right information, it's a simple process! Check out this short video that explains what the FAFSA is: FAFSA ® Explained. Jax State encourages all admitted students to complete the FAFSA ® . First-time freshmen who submit their FAFSA to Jax State by April 1, 2025, and have a Student Aid Index (SAI) of \$15,000 or less, as calculated by the FAFSA ® , will receive a \$750 FAFSA Completion Grant.

How can you prepare for the FAFSA ® opening on Dec. 1? Make sure you have everything you need, like creating a StudentAid.gov account, by visiting this helpful page.

We'll send a reminder when the FAFSA ® opens and follow up with digital and mailed communication letting you know how much aid you've been offered, including federal financial aid and Jax State scholarships. This way, you'll have a clearer idea of your costs after your FAFSA ® is received and processed.
