The incorporation of Quality Assurance and Quality Control Measures into Crime Scene Investigations will be the emphasis of this 4 hour block of training. Participants will be introduced to sterile techniques that should be utilized when documenting and collecting biological samples.

At the completion of training, participants will be issued a Crime Scene Kit containing supplies to document and collect potential items of evidence.

Class size will be limited to 50 personnel that actively process crime scenes. Due to the limited number of kits, only 2 participants from an agency will be allowed to attend.
