

Basic Information

• Sophomore members of the Honors Program in good standing are eligible to apply for the study abroad experience.

To qualify, a student must:

- Submit their plan to complete the Honors Program.*
- o have a minimum 3.25 GPA
- o enroll in UH 399 Study Abroad course in Spring 2022.
- We will know exact May departure dates 90 days out. EF will be pairing us with students from other universities to provide an opportunity to get to know other students and to keep the price lower.
- Deadline to enroll is December 2021 but early enrollment equals lower prices.
- Students must enroll with the name listed on their passports.
- If you do not yet have a passport, you must purchase a passport and provide a copy to the Honors Program by March 15, 2022.
- See the budget sheet for detailed information.
- Students, at their own expense, do have the option of extending their stay in Ireland and EF can arrange their flight home. Students will be responsible for any flight increase as a result of changes to their departure date. Students wishing to extend their stay in Ireland should inform the Honors Program and EF as soon as possible to secure the best pricing.

- 1. Students must submit a plan of study* for Honors prior to being permitted to enroll in the study tour. Students who enroll in the Irish Heritage EF Study Tour who do not comply with the academic or other requirements will not be allowed to participate. Students must earn a B average in each honors course and maintain a 3.25 GPA. All Honors courses must be taken at JSU.
- 2. Students will attend all classes for UH 399 and complete all assignments.
