




Enrollment By Gender












Graduate Enrollment 1,467 graduate students make up 16% of JSU's total enrollment.



First-Time Freshmen


1,252 First-Time Freshmen make up **13%** of JSU Students



The average age of First-Time Freshmen is **18** while the average age of First-Time Transfer Students is **25**.


First-Time Transfers




3,334 JSU Students are enrolled in Distance Education courses this fall.
