





Fall 2011 Enrollment 9,490

Enrollment By Gender













Graduate Enrollment 1,291 graduate students make up 14% of JSU's total enrollment.



First-Time Freshmen



1,414 First-Time Freshmen make up **15%** of JSU's total enrollment.

771 students transferred to JSU this fall.




International Student Enrollment


Distance Education
