




Enrollment by Gender






Undergraduate Students by Status




Undergraduate Students by Status and Gender

Undergraduate Students by Classification




Graduate Enrollment: 1,158

graduate students make up **14%** of JSU's total enrollment, and **14%** of JSU's graduate enrollment.


Graduate Students by Gender




The average age of First-Time

First-Time Freshman Gender





568 students transferred to JSU this fall.


The average age of First-Time

First-Time Transfer Status




First-Time Transfer Gender


