




## Enrollment by College and Status


## Enrollment by Gender




# Undergraduate Enrollment 7,149

Undergraduate students make up **84%** of JSU's total Spring 2022 enrollment.




## By Gender




# Graduate Enrollment 1,335\*

Graduate students make up **16%** of JSU's total Spring 2022 enrollment.








# Distance Education\*
