Level 1 - Basic SWAT

Program Description: This approved Basic Tactical Operator Course (BTOC) will certify each student. Anyone certified LEO may attend this training, assignment to a team is not necessary. The training days are long. The course requires moderate to high levels of physical fitness.

Credentialing: This course is for active, certified and credentialed law enforcement officers (LEOs) with detention and arrest authority.

Equipment List: Each student needs to bring:

- ❖ Wrap around eye protection, Hearing protection (bring lots of foam hearing protection)
- ❖ Body armor/tactical vest/gloves
- ❖ Flashlight: weapon mounted and/or handheld with spare batteries
- ❖ Duty pistol, 3 magazines and holster – Live Pistol Ammunition: 300 Rounds
- ❖ A zero'ed rifle, 3 magazines, Live Rifle Ammunition: 150 Rounds
- ❖ Groin protection (Small towel or athletic cup) to protect your groin area
- ❖ Long sleeve T-shirts or light weight jackets (no red clothing – Instructors wear red)
- ❖ Throat protection (towel) and groin protection (towel)
- ❖ Coolers with food, ice and drinks (we allow these items in the training area)
- ❖ Non-lethal training weapon (Glock 17T or similar) – we can provide if necessary
- ❖ Season weather clothing (Rain gear, changes of clothes, etc...)



NOTE: This course uses non-lethal training ammunition during force-on-force training. Students must bring items that cover exposed skin during training. Bring something to cover your neck, arms, hands and pad the groin area.

Training Ammunition: Each student needs to bring:

- ❖ 150 Pistol Non-lethal training ammunition (NLTA) rounds that fit Glock 17T handgun
- ❖ 20 Rifle 5.56 Rounds of Force-on-Force
- ❖ If you cannot provide rounds, please contact Dave personally (256.525.9808)
- ❖ Payment: **There are additional fees when paying by credit card.** This is a prepaid course as required to ARM Group. BEFORE the class begins.

We train in all weather conditions except for lightning or other extremely hazardous conditions.
