Adam Hayes is an internationally recognized performer, educator, and clinician. A versatile musician, Adam has performed throughout North America, South America, Europe, and Asia, including performances with over 40 professional orchestras throughout the world. With an interest in new music and creative music, Adam endeavors to promote the latest in solo trumpet repertoire. His debut album CURRENT, recorded with pianist Kris Carlisle, features innovative compositions for solo trumpet and piano and is distributed internationally on Curvepoint Media. Several of Adam's solo, chamber and orchestral recordings have been broadcast on radio and television. He can be heard on labels including ACA, 5ive Happiness, Curvepoint, Hal Leonard, and Mark Records. Adam Hayes is Artist-in-Residence and Assistant Professor of Music at Berry College in Rome, GA. He holds the Doctor of Musical Arts degree from The University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, a Master of Music from the University of New Mexico, and a Bachelor of Music from The University of Georgia. He is an artist/clinician for Eastman Trumpets.

Renowned percussion artist John David has performed throughout the United States and Europe in a variety of classical, jazz, and commercial settings. Currently residing in Atlanta, John is one of the most sought-after percussionists in the nation. Known for his infectious grooves, John is also an accomplished studio drummer having played on many commercial recordings. Some notable artists he has performed with include Arturo Sandoval, Bruce Hornsby, and the Jaco Pastorius Big Band. He has twice received international awards from Downbeat Magazine. In addition to his active performing schedule, John currently teaches percussion and jazz at Berry College and the University of North Georgia. He received his training at the University of Miami, University of Georgia and Columbus State University.

Kris Carlisle received his training at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music and the Claremont Graduate University. He has studied with such noted artists as Louanne Long, Mack McCray, Lita Guerra, and Susan Svrcek. He has been the winner of many competitions and the recipient of various awards including: the Martha Fischer-Tye Foundation Award; a Special Achievement in Musicology Award from the Kennedy Center, Washington D.C.; and a Georgia Music Teachers Steinway Piano Galleries Educator Grant. Specializing in contemporary music, Dr. Carlisle is currently promoting his latest album with trumpet artist, Adam Hayes. The album CURRENT, is a collection of contemporary works for piano and trumpet. This collaborative album features innovative compositions for trumpet and piano and is distributed internationally on Curvepoint Media. Along with soprano Dina Cancryn, Dr. Carlisle has served as Artist in Residence at the Banff Centre for the Arts in Banff, Canada exposing audiences to the works of contemporary American composers. His recording project, The American Evolution - explores the ways in which contemporary American composers have used traditional compositional genres while incorporating contemporary musical language.
