

## ABOUT OUR GUEST CLINICIAN:

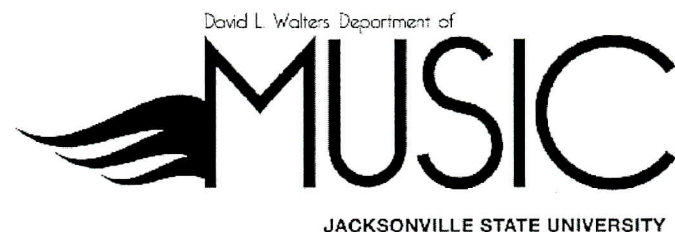
