PSY 480/481 Community Practicum

Prerequisites: permission of instructor.

Practice of psychological techniques in a community organization such as mental health clinics, juvenile detention centers, etc.

Grades: Pass/Fail

PSY 485/486 Applied Behavior Analysis Practicum

Prerequisites: PSY 220, PSY 221 and permission of instructor. Practice of behavior analysis principles in applied settings such as developmental centers and organizations.

Grades: Pass/Fail

Minimum Practicum Requirements (see syllabus for details)

- 135 hours of service completed between the first day of classes and last day of finals (approximately 9 hrs/15 weeks in fall/spring; approximately 11 hrs/12 weeks in summer)
- Summary of your experience as it relates to your psychology coursework
- Performance evaluation from on-site supervisor
- Adherence to all the policies that are enforced by the community organization at which you work

Procedure for Enrolling in a Psychology Practicum Course

Recommended: Prior to starting your search for a practicum site, schedule a meeting with our practicum coordinator, Dr. Bayles (mbayles@jsu.edu), to discuss which practicum would be best for you.

- 1. Identify a community organization where you would like to complete your practicum (use the examples below or create your own). Note, Applied Behavior Analysis Practicums must be completed under the supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). The community organization should be one that uses psychological or behavior analytic techniques to provide services to individuals. Your experience at this organization can range from observing techniques being delivered to implementing them with supervision, depending on the specific organization. Do NOT contact private counseling offices/centers (e.g., Bodenheimer Psychological and Counseling Center), outside of the ones listed, because these sites cannot provide practicum opportunities due to client confidentiality issues.
- 2. Contact a supervisor at the organization to inquire about volunteering as a practicum student. This supervisor is responsible for all your supervision in the community setting, including but not limited to, scheduling hours, training, and performance feedback (if necessary). Dr. Bayles will oversee your practicum experience via written summaries, and she will contact your community supervisor to verify completion of hours and overall job performance.
- 3. **Email Dr. Bayles** (mbayles@jsu.edu), the practicum coordinator, to present your practicum plan. Please send her the organization's name, a brief description of the job, the supervisor's name, and the supervisor's contact information (email address preferred). After evaluating the plan, you will either be approved to enroll, or suggestions will be made for alternative practicum opportunities.
